If you consider that God is some mysterious being that we cannot know much about, perhaps you have been ignoring two impressive pieces of evidence:

- (1) The Creation that we inhabit and interact with daily. It doesn't take much examination to conclude that it is the product of a wise and intelligent creator. Just to take one example; the human eye is a magical mechanism that works at a level of sophistication that scientists cannot reproduce.

"If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the **Lord Jesus** and believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." (Romans 10:9)

"The blood of **Jesus Christ**, His (God's) Son, cleanses us from all sin." (1 John 1:7)

"Without controversy, great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the nations, believed on in the world, received up into glory."(1 Timothy 3:16)

It is only through **Jesus Christ** that we can obtain an appreciation and understanding of God, who is so beautifully displayed to us in the gift, life, words, works, death and resurrection of **Jesus**, the eternal Son of God. The key, unchanging, characteristics of God are *Lovingkindness*, *Judgment and Righteousness* (Jeremiah 9:24). The only way that judgment and righteousness could ever prevail among sinful men and women, is through the loving hand of God in giving His Son to die in our place.

Get to know **Jesus Christ** as your Saviour, and the mysteries evaporate.
